

## Wakehurst Place

### Example Itinerary for a group Visit

---

- 10.30am Arrive at Wakehurst Place  
Coffee may be taken in the Seed Café at the Visitor Centre  
Met by a guide and enjoy a tour of the gardens including an overview of the collection and the history of the site. The tour ends at the Millennium Seed Bank with your guide giving an overview of the work carried out there.
- 11.30am Visit the Seed Bank Exhibition  
Discover the importance of seed in conservation and learn more about the worldwide effort to store and conserve seeds which Kew is leading.
- 12.15am Visit the Mansion exhibition space  
Several rooms downstairs in the Mansion have been opened for viewing, including exhibition space for an ongoing temporary exhibition programme.
- 12.45pm Lunch in the Stables Restaurant
- From 1.30pm Free time in the garden, walk around the lake, visit the walled garden, the woodlands, conservation zone or take a seat and relax in the peace and quiet. There is also the chance to visit the shop and plant sales area.
